## ASBESTOS INSPECTOR TRAINING

### Asbestos Inspector Workshop

Many weatherization and home performance jobs are stopped in their tracks because of suspected Asbestos-Containing Materials (ACMs) in the home. This interactive course will guide participants through the process of safely and legally evaluating these materials, with the intent of helping these projects go forward. These inspection procedures, and the content of this class, are determined by guidelines in the federal Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA).

This is a 24-hour course with ample hands-on study and practice. It's approved by the Montana Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) as part of the Montana Asbestos Control Program.

There will be a final exam on the last day of class. Participants who pass the exam may apply for accreditation as an Asbestos Inspector, at their own cost, through DEQ. The instructor will assist participants in submitting that application after the class.

The instructors for this class are from *CTA Environmental* in Great Falls.
