## LEAD INSPECTOR & RISK ASSESSOR TRAINING



January 28 - February 1, 2019

### Lead Inspector and Risk Assessor Initial Training

This 40-hour course meets the requirements of EPA and HUD regarding certification of Lead Inspectors and Lead-Based Paint Risk Assessors. Participants will have the option to attend either 1) the 24-hour Lead Inspector course only, or 2) the complete 40-hour Inspector + Risk Assessor course.

This course includes a mix of classroom training and hands-on exercises that'll prepare you for realistic job-site scenarios. Successful participants will be prepared to take the third-party certification exam at a later date. Topics for this workshop include:

- Background of lead contamination
- Health effects of lead poisoning
- Complying with regulations and recordkeeping responsibilities
- Identifying and controlling lead hazards
- Inspection and sampling methods including X-ray fluorescence (XRF)
- Performing risk assessments
- Developing work plans
- Meeting reporting requirements
